Halliburton Hosts Job Fair in Louisiana to Fill Positions Worldwide

HOUSTON, TX – Aug. 17, 2010 – Halliburton (NYSE: HAL) will host a job fair in Lafayette, Louisiana on August 18 and 19 with the intention of interviewing applicants to fill open positions worldwide.
